

# Instructions on How To Access Recordings from 21<sup>st</sup> World Congress of Qigong/Tai Chi/Traditional Chinese Medicine/Natural Healing.

## Background

World Tai Chi & Qigong Day was asked to ask our favorite presenters to take part in the 21<sup>st</sup> World Congress of Qigong/Tai Chi/Traditional Chinese Medicine/Natural Healing from April 23 – 26, 2021. We also did a two hour workshop for them from 10:15 to 12:15 Pacific Time.

We were told that people would be able to watch this event from a streaming service in the United States. Unfortunately, the streaming connection did not appear to work correctly, so only very beginning of the first day appeared at that connection.

Furthermore, the other days had many technical problems. Since World Tai Chi & Qigong Day was not responsible for the event, there we nothing we could do about the technical difficulties.

However, that does not mean that all is lost. You can access whatever recordings from the Congress that you can by following these directions.

## Step 1: Create an account and login


The event was streamed to a Chinese website called <https://www.qihuanghealthcare.cn/> In order to view the recordings, you must create an account and log into this website.

First, go to <https://www.qihuanghealthcare.cn/live/detail/865> and the login screen will come up along with a place to switch to English instructions instead of Chinese.



Click on **English** so that you can read the instructions.

Choose the **Register** tab and create a username and password. The username is either **case sensitive**, or all lowercase, which is not typical. If you create a login with [cjrroads@hplconsortium.com](mailto:cjrroads@hplconsortium.com) and then type in [CJRroads@hplconsortium.com](mailto:CJRroads@hplconsortium.com), the site will tell you that the account doesn't exist, but if you try to recreate it, it will tell you the member already exists. (I know, very frustrating). So it is best to use all lowercase to Register and then use all lowercase when you Log in.




Once you've created an account, go back and login with the username and password (remember lower case).
